Special Student Development Programmes Offered

To broaden the learning experiences of students, Jurongville Secondary School plans and implements an Applied Learning Programme (ALP) and a Learning for Life Programme (LLP). The school's ALP is 'Real-World Learning Through Electronics'. Through various authentic tasks, students learn and apply concepts relating to electronics. Lower secondary students, for instance, use their knowledge to design tools and equipment that can potentially be used to improve our quality of life. Upper secondary students who wish to deepen their knowledge can also choose to offer Electronics ("O" Levels) or Smart Electrical Technology ("N" Levels). With such early exposure to electronics, our students are more ready to consider STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics) professional courses beyond secondary schools. The school's Learning for Life Programme, 'Sports for Life', gives all students the opportunity to learn and enjoy a variety of sports electives. The intent of such broad exposure is to enhance individual well-being, develop a team-oriented mind-set, and nurture a healthy and positive outlook to life. Through the programme, students also develop their leadership skills with the guidance of teachers, and selected sports CCA students are given valuable learning opportunities beyond the school.
