

ITE Early Admissions Exercise (EAE)

- Students can apply based on their **interest and abilities** in the courses they are applying to.
- Students **can apply for 3 courses**.
- They will receive **one offer to accept**.
- Students who **confirmed an offer** are **not allowed** to:
 - change courses
 - change ITE Colleges
 - Participate in JIE (admissions when N-level results are released)
- Students **must still meet the minimum entry requirements (MERs) of the course offered**.
