## **No Lesson on Marking Day (17 May 2019)**

On **Friday, 17 May 2019**, the school has set aside time for our teachers to mark the mid-year examination scripts. All our students are not required to report to school on Marking Day.

School will resume as normal for all our students on **21 May 2019 (Tuesday)** after the Vesak Day public holiday.

## **Mother Tongue Languages Intensive Revision Programme (23, 27 - 30 May 2019)**

The school is conducting a structured Mother-Tongue Languages Intensive Revision Programme (MTLIRP) for all graduating classes (Sec 4Exp, 4NA "O" & 5NA) who offer Mother Tongue Language subjects at GCE 'O' Level. The MTIRP is intended to help our students do as well as they can for the "O" level examination on **3 June 2019**.

The programme will commence after the school's mid-year examinations on **Thursday, 23 May and Monday to Thursday, 27 - 30 May 2019**. The morning session of the programme is for all students. The afternoon session is conducted from 2.45 pm onwards and is for *selected* students. Your child/ ward will only need to attend it if required to do so by their Mother Tongue teachers.

Kindly remind your child / ward of the need to revise and prepare well for "O" level examination on 3 June.

The school will also be conducting a half-day Mother Tongue Oral Preparatory Workshop on **Tuesday, 25 June 2019**. This workshop is intended to enhance the oracy skills of our graduating students, in preparation for the MTL GCE 'O' Level Oral Examinations. The examination will start from **Tuesday, 9 July** onwards, when school resumes in Term 3. Please ensure that your child/ ward attends the workshop as scheduled.



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## **Parent-Student-Teacher Meeting (31 May 2019)**

The school values all our students and aims to work closely with you to develop your child/ward to his/her fullest potential. With this objective in mind, we would like to invite you to meet up with your child's/ward's Class Mentor on **Friday, 31 May 2019 between 7.40 am to 3 pm**. The purpose of this session is to update you on your child's/ward's academic performance, conduct and other matters relevant to your child/ward's learning and well-being. The meeting with each parent / guardian is expected to take about 20 minutes.

If you are unable to attend the session on Friday, 31 May, kindly make alternative arrangement to meet your child's/ward's Class Mentor on another day for the discussion. Your child's/ward's progress card will be given to you during the meeting.

Our students are expected to be present with their parents / guardians during the meeting. They are also expected to be in their school uniform.

## **Study Camp for Graduating Classes (24 – 26 June 2019)**

The school has planned a study camp for the graduating classes. The timetable is attached for your reference.

The objective of the study camp is to consolidate students' learning in preparation for the GCE 'O' Level examination. It is **compulsory** and it will be held from **Monday, 24 June to Wednesday, 26 June**. For **selected coursework students**, they will be expected to come back during the **first 2 weeks of June**.

We would like to have your support to ensure that your child/ward:

- is punctual for all his/her lessons;
- is clear about the specific dates and duration of the lessons he/she will be attending;
- consistently does his/her assignments / projects / revision work as part of his/her preparation for the "O" levels
